NOTICE OF RACE

LAKE WINNIPESAUKEE SAILING ASSOCIATION

Organizing Authority and J80 Fleet 1 Host Present the

18th Annual J Jamboree

J80 East Coast Championship on Lake Winnipesaukee Gilford, New Hampshire

Friday, September 9 through Sunday, September 11, 2005

1.0 SITE: Lake Winnipesaukee, New Hampshire. Race headquarters, launch, and haul out will be at Fay's Boat Yard in Gilford, NH. The Barbecue will be at the Winnipesaukee Yacht Club. Racing will be on the main portion of Lake Winnipesaukee.

2.0 RULES: This regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the J80 class rules, the Notice of Race, and by the Sailing Instructions.

2.1 A time limit of 30 minutes after the first boat finishes a race will apply. Boats that started a race and did not finish within that limit will be scored one point more than the number of finishers in the race. This changes rules 35 and A4.

2.2 Rule changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY: Open to all J/80 class yachts as defined by the class association. Competitors must meet all ownership, class membership and yacht measurement requirements and must have paid all dues and event fees before becoming official competitors. All competitors shall be weighed in prior to the first warning and each yacht's total crew weight shall not exceed the Class limit. This regatta is designated a J/80 *member* event. See the <u>Class</u> <u>Rules</u> C.2.3 for restrictions on eligible helmsmen.

4.0 ENTRY FEES: The Entry Fee of \$80.00 includes Launching, Haul Out, Mooring, Beer at Launching and Haul Out, T-shirt and barbecue ticket for skipper. There is an additional charge of \$8.00 if the owner or skipper is not a member of the US Sailing Association. In order for us to provide enough Beer and Food, we request that all entries be received **as early as possible**. For this reason, there is a late registration fee of \$10.00 if received after Thursday, Sept 1st.

NOTE: Early registration is requested. The order of Haul Out on Sunday afternoon will based on the order of registrations received. Final registration will close at 0930 on Saturday at Fay's Boat Yard in Gilford, NH.

5.0 RACING: Racing will be on windward/ leeward courses. The windward mark will include an offset mark. A gate may be used as the leeward mark. The racing on Saturday will include as many races as we can run. Sunday's racing will be planned to hopefully have all boats **out of the water** by 1730.

6.0 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Friday, September 9, 2005

1300 to 1900 - Launching, Registration and Weigh-In (Fay's Boat Yard) NOTE: No boats will be launched after 1900 on Friday evening.

Saturday, September 10, 2005

0900 to 0930 - Final Registration and Weigh-In (Fay's Boat Yard)

- 0930 Skippers' Meeting (Fay's Boat Yard)
- 1100 Warning Signal for first race (about 2 miles out)
- 1800 Barbecue at Winnipesaukee Yacht Club

Sunday, September 11, 2005

1000 - Warning Signal for first race (about 2 miles out) No warning signal shall be given after 1400

After Racing - Haul Out and Awards (note: Haul out will be in order of registrations received)

Skipper's Meeting: A Skipper's Meeting will be held at 0930 Saturday at Fay's to answer questions and introduce the Race Committee.

7.0 SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System, as provided in Appendix A4 of the *Racing Rules of Sailing* will be used, as changed below.

7.1 Two completed races will constitute the series and if more than six races are completed a boat's worst finish will be deleted from its final score.

7.2 Boats that started a race and did not finish within the time limit will be scored one point more than the number of finishers in the race. This changes rules 35 and A4.

8.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The sailing instructions will be available after August 15th at <u>http://www.lwsa.org/j-jamboree/</u>.

9.0 COMMUNICATION: All boats shall carry an operable VHF Radio and are encouraged to monitor Channel 72.9.1 While racing, boats shall neither make radio transmissions nor receive transmissions not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10.0 PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded for the top four finishing places.
