

1.0 SITE: Lake Winnepesaukee, New Hampshire. Race headquarters will be located at the Dave Adams Memorial Sailing Center ("DAMSC"), 25 Davis Road, Gilford NH. Launch and haul-out will occur at Fay's Boat Yard, Gilford, NH. Racing will be on the main portion of Lake Winnepesaukee, approximately 1.5 miles east of DAMSC.

2.0 RULES: This regatta will be governed by the 2013-2016 *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the J80 class rules, this Notice of Race, and by the Sailing Instructions.

2.1 A time limit of 30 minutes after the first boat finishes a race will apply. Boats that started a race and did not finish within that limit will be scored one point more than the number of finishers in the race. This changes rules 35 and A4.

2.2 Rule changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY: Open to all J/80 class yachts as defined by the Class Association. Competitors must meet all ownership, class membership and yacht measurement requirements and must have paid all dues and event fees before becoming official competitors. In place of an official weigh-in, skippers shall be required to sign an official crew weight declaration form which is an appendix of the sailing instructions.

4.0 ENTRY FEES: The Entry Fee of \$225 includes Launching, Haul Out, Mooring, 4 T-shirts and Social ticket for skipper. The Entry Fee for a member of the US Sailing Association is \$200. In order for us to properly plan the event's activities, we request that all entries be received **as early as possible**. For this reason, there is a late registration fee of \$30 if received after Monday, June 1st.

NOTE: The order of Haul Out on Sunday afternoon will be based on the order of longest distance traveled. Final registration will close at 1500 on Friday at Race Headquarters at DASC.

5.0 RACING: Racing will be on windward/ leeward courses with marks left to port. The windward mark may include an offset buoy. A gate may be used as the leeward mark. Sunday's racing will be planned so that all boats will be **out of the water** by 1800.

6.0 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Friday, June 6, 2014

1000 to 1430 – Launching at Fay's Boat Yard; Registration

1430 – Skippers meeting at DAMSC

1445 – Harbor Start

1530 – Warning Signal for first race (about 1 ½ miles out)

1930 - Welcome Get Together at the DAMSC, Gilford, NH

Saturday, June 7, 2014

0930 – Harbor Start

1030 – Warning Signal for first race (about 1 ½ miles out)

1800 – J Jamboree Regatta Party at the DAMSC

Sunday, June 8, 2014

0900 - Harbor Start

1000 – Warning Signal for first race (about 1 ½ miles out)

No warning signal shall be given after 1400

1530 - Awards at DAMSC

7.0 SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System, as provided in Appendix A4 of the *Racing Rules of Sailing* will be used.

7.1 Two completed races will constitute the series and if more than six races are completed a boat's worst finish will be deleted from its final score.

7.2 Boats that started a race and did not finish within the time limit will be scored one point more than the number of finishers in the race. This changes rules 35 and A4.

8.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

9.0 COMMUNICATION: All boats shall carry an operable VHF Radio and are encouraged to monitor Channel 72.

9.1 While racing, boats shall neither make radio transmissions nor receive transmissions not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10.0 PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded for the top three finishing places.
