## Notice of Race

Saturday September 19 and Sunday, September 20, 2015

**1.0 SITE:** Lake Winnepesaukee, New Hampshire. Race headquarters will be located at the Dave Adams Memorial Sailing Center, 25 Davis Road, Gilford NH 03249. Registration will be at Fay's Boat Yard, Gilford, NH. Launch and haul-out will occur at Fay's Boat Yard, Gilford, NH. Racing will be on the main portion of Lake Winnepesaukee, approximately 1.5 miles east of race headquarters.

**2.0 RULES:** This regatta will be governed by the 2013-2016 *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the J/80 class rules, the J/70 Class rules, this Notice of Race, and by the Sailing Instructions.

**2.1** A time limit of 30 minutes after the first boat finishes a race will apply. Boats start a race and do not finish within said time limit will be scored one point more than the number of finishers in the race. This changes rules 35 and A4.

**2.2** Rule changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

**3.0 ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all J/80 and J/70 class yachts as defined by their respective Class Association. Competitors must meet all ownership, class membership and yacht measurement requirements and must have paid all dues and event fees before becoming official competitors. Where Class rules restrict crew weight, skippers shall be required to sign an official crew weight declaration form in place of an official weigh-in, which is an appendix of the sailing instructions.

**4.0 ENTRY FEES:** The Entry Fee of \$200 includes Launching, Haul Out, Mooring, one (1) piece of J Jamboree apparel and one (1) social ticket. In order for us to properly plan the event=s activities, we request that all entries be received **as early as possible**. For this reason, there is a

late registration fee of \$30 if received after Saturday, September 12<sup>th</sup>. Registration will close at 1800 on Friday, September 18, 2015 at Fay's Boat Yard.

**5.0 RACING:** Racing will be on windward/ leeward courses with marks left to port. The windward mark may include an offset buoy. A gate may be substituted for the leeward mark.

## **6.0 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:**

### **Friday, September 18, 2015**

1000 to 1430 Launching at Fay's Boat Yard

1000 to 1800 Registration at Fay's Boat Yard

1930 - Welcome Get Together at the David Adams Sailing Center, 25 Davis Rd, Gilford, NH 03249

### **Saturday, September 19, 2015**

0930 - Harbor Start

1030 - Warning Signal for first race (about 1.5 miles out)

1800 - J-Jamboree Regatta Party at the WYC

### **Sunday, September 20, 2015**

0900 - Harbor Start

1000 - Warning Signal for first race (about 1.5 miles out)

No warning signal shall be given after 1400

1530 - Awards ceremony at Fays boatyard immediately following haul out.

**NOTE: The order of Haul Out on Sunday afternoon will be based on the order of longest distance traveled.**

**7.0 SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System, as provided in Appendix A4 of the *Racing Rules of Sailing* will be used.

**7.1** Two completed races will constitute the series and if more than six races are completed a boat's worst finish will be deleted from its final score.

**7.2** Boats that start a race and do not finish within the proscribed time limit will be scored one point more than the number of finishers in the race. This changes rules 35 and A4.

**9.0 COMMUNICATION:** All boats shall carry an operable VHF Radio and are encouraged to monitor Channel 72.

**9.1** While racing, boats shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions or any other form of electronic/digital communication not available to all boats.

**10.0 PRIZES:** Prizes will be awarded for the top three finishing boats in each class. The J/80 East Coast Championship trophy will be awarded to the top finisher in the J/80 Class, and the top finishing J/70 will be crowned the New Hampshire State Champion.
